Town of Discovery Bay	1	<p>The Town of Discovery Bay previously sent a letter regarding the environmental review of the Bay Delta Conservation Plan/California WaterFix project. The Town explained that the draft documents prepared were technically and legally inadequate and that they did not comply with CEQA and NEPA. At the time, we asked that the Department of Water Resources prepare and recirculate a revised BDCP and accompanying environmental documents that include alternatives that reduce water exports and increase Delta flows.</p>	<p>This comment is about previously submitted comments regarding CEQA/NEPA adequacy. This comment does not raise any substantive new environmental information or analysis that was not previously addressed in the Final EIR/S.</p>
